Since 1968, over 7.6 million people have seen The Great Passion Play in Eureka Springs, Arkansas. Tucked away in the picturesque Ozark Mountains, the amphitheater transports you over 2,000 years ago to witness the majesty of Jesus Christ's life, betrayal, death, and glorious resurrection.

A cast of over 125 actors and dozens of birds and animals perform the Play on a set built into the hillside. The set is three-stories-tall and 550 feet across - the size of two football fields. Yet each of the 4,000 seats is close enough for you to clearly see and hear the Greatest Story Ever Told.

The Christ of the Ozarks Statue

"And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will draw all men unto me."

- John 12:32

The Christ of the Ozarks Statue stands at 67 feet with an arm span of 65 feet. Since 1967, the giant figure has overlooked the Victorian village of Eureka Springs, Arkansas. The inspiring image of the seven-story statue may be seen from the village's historic district below.

Sacred Arts Center



With pieces dating back to the ninth century, the Sacred Arts Center features a diverse mix of artistic mediums portraying Christ and the Christian life. In fact, there are over 1,000 works of art in 64 different forms, making it one of the most expansive collections of Christ-centered art. Along with classic masterpieces, the Center showcases art by contemporary Christian artists, such as Jack Dawson.

Bible Museum



With over 7,000 Bibles in 625 languages and dialects, along with a large collection of parchments, the Bible Museum is one of the most visited and impressive of its kind. Among the most important artifacts include: an original 1611 King James Bible, a page of the Gutenberg Bible (only 47 are in existence today), an 1898 Bible signed by all of the original Gideons (the only one of its kind), and numerous others.
