2025 GREAT PASSION PLAY SOUNDTRACK PROJECT



PROJECT OVERVIEW

John has been the orchestrator for Second Baptist Houston for 18 years. Second Baptist, led by Dr. Ed Young, is one of the largest churches in America with a membership of over 90,000. This role has allowed him to connect to top performers in the Evangelical community.

Phase 1: \$15,000

Pre-production costs, score development and initial securing of team (orchestrators/copyist for sheet music preparation, recording engineers and audio stem production).

BUDAPEST ORCHESTRA

<u>Phase 2: \$55,000</u>

Projected Need is April 1, 2024. Recording and prep fees for the Budapest Scoring Orchestra (used by Universal, Legendary Films, the Walt Disney Company, Lucas Film, Netflix, FOX News and many more...). Secure additional instrumentalists, audio engineers and sound design creation. The current score for The Great Passion Play was composed and arranged by Phil Perkins and performed by the National Philharmonic Orchestra of London in 1984. While certainly a feat in its time, it is outdated and has been spliced together and almost butchered to fit the Play as it is performed today.

The majority of the vocal performances for the current Play were done by our cast in 2008, 2012, 2013, and 2014. These recordings were done on a volunteer basis and were done in a church and not a recording studio because of costs.

In the current Play, some recordings were used from as far back as 1984. While the Play in pacing and special effects has improved, the splicing together of instrumental and vocal performances is detrimental to its quality. We need to record the voices with professional actors and in a professional setting. John is capable and connected to lead this effort.



Nestled in Central Europe, Budapest Orchestra combines centuries of musical heritage with modern state-of-the-art analog and digital recording equipment. In the 1980s, film studios began looking for locations outside of the US and UK to record the highest quality film music within their shrinking budgets and turned to Budapest. Becoming the first and one of the best-loved destinations for film scoring sessions, Budapest has hosted Jerry Goldsmith, Michel Legrand, Alan Menken, Ennio Morricone and others who flew to Hungary to record music for movies such as RAMBO, A CHRISTMAS CAROL, LIONHEART, EXTREME PREJUDICE, and RENT A COP.

In 2019, the Budapest Orchestra performed the score for the movie PARASITE, which won the Academy Award's Best Picture. The Budapest Orchestra also performed in the faith-based films LEFT BEHIND and I AM NOT ASHAMED.




The musical score for the Passion Play will sound more like THE PASSION OF THE CHRIST by John Debney and similar to orchestrations by James Horner (BRAVEHEART, TITANIC, LEGENDS OF THE FALL, A BEAUTIFUL MIND, and AVATAR) than the John Williams and "Star Wars" style orchestration that it sounds like currently.

Phase 3: \$40,000

Projected Need is August 1, 2024. Script production (recording fees, actor compensation, etc.) Score mix development with mixing engineer. This phase may need increased funding depending on the fees charged for professional recording actors. For instance, the plan is for many of the cast members from the hit television series, "The Chosen" to be the vocal actors.





Phase 4: \$40,000 Projected Need is January 15, 2025. Finalize mixing and mastering of final score/script for show ready content.

The primary focus of this stage is getting the Passion Play show ready for opening night of the 2025 season on Good Friday, April 18, 2025. The soundtrack will be laid out to follow the action of the show, but we will also have the capability to achieve surround sound.

TOTAL FINANCIAL NEED FOR NEW SOUNDTRACK: \$150,000

This figure will produce a vastly superior show theatrically than what we have now. Using more named talent will put upward pressure on this budget. However, we feel that this budget is achievable and will allow The Great Passion Play to reach this next generation more effectively with Christ's story.
